

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
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The New Zealand wine industry have over the past few years lost two of its most influential pioneers with the passing of Peter Babich (1932–2025) and Joe Babich (1940–2022).

As brothers and business partners, their leadership and vision helped shape Babich Wines into one of New Zealand's most respected and enduring wineries.

Born into a winemaking family, Peter and Joe followed in the footsteps of their father, Josip Babich, who founded Babich Wines in 1916. Peter joined the business in 1949 at just 17, while Joe followed in 1958 after briefly considering a career in pharmacy. Together, they transformed Babich Wines from a small, family-run operation into an internationally recognized brand, with their wines now exported to over 60 markets worldwide.


Peter was a respected industry leader, known for

his integrity, warmth, and commitment to quality. He played a key role in expanding Babich Wines' vineyards and production, ensuring the company's long-term success. His contributions were recognized with numerous accolades, including an MBE in 1989, a Fellowship of the Wine Institute of New Zealand in 1995, and induction into the New Zealand Wine Hall of Fame in 2015.

Joe, a gifted winemaker, was renowned for his craftsmanship and willingness to push boundaries. He pioneered barrel fermentation for New Zealand Chardonnay, creating the now-iconic Irongate Chardonnay. Over his 60-year career, he received multiple honours, including the ONZM for services to the wine industry in 2015 and induction into both the New Zealand Wine and West Auckland Business Halls of Fame.



#### 1.What are five pieces every woman needs in their wardrobe?

- A classic white shirt and/or a classic white t-shirt. These are an obvious go-to for layering and act as 'building blocks' in any wardrobe.
- The best quality knitwear you can afford in simple styles that don't date, like a classic crew-neck or V-neck. These are perfect for layering and can be paired back with jeans, worn under a suit or dressed up with great jewellery for an evening out.

- 2. What's your top three tips for women wanting to level up their personal style?





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### BABICH WINES Vintage 2025 is Upon Us

As the 2025 grape harvest approaches, Babich Wines reflects on the season's conditions in Hawke's Bay and Marlborough, anticipating a promising yield.

The Hawke's Bay, renowned for its exceptional Bordeaux style wines, has experienced favourable weather patterns this season. The region has seen its usual temperate, maritime-influenced weather conditions, characterized by warm, sunny days and cool nights. These conditions have provided the optimal environment for grape maturation and the development of depth and complexity of flavour in varieties such as Syrah, Merlot, and Chardonnay.

Harvest in Babich Wines' Hawke's Bay vineyards started in late February, with a slightly extended ripening period enhancing the depth and character of the fruit. Babich Wines' famous Irongate Vineyard in the Gimblett Gravels will be one of the first to be harvested. These grapes will contribute to the winery's iconic Irongate Chardonnay, which this year celebrates its 39th vintage. The chardonnay will be quickly followed by red varieties found in Irongate



vineyard along with the family's four other vineyards. The anticipated yield aligns with projections, promising a vintage reflective of the region's distinctive terroir.

Marlborough, celebrated for its vibrant Sauvignon Blanc and a rich, textural style of Pinot Noir, has experienced a season marked by a cool flowering period followed by a warm summer. These cool conditions necessitated careful vineyard management to maintain fruit quality, however after frost and weather conditions resulted in 20-25% lower crop than the long-term average, 2025 is shaping up to be one of the biggest vintages on record.

Babich Wines' Marlborough vineyards are expected to begin harvesting in early-March, focusing initially on Pinot Noir before moving to Sauvignon Blanc and other varieties. While the yield is projected to be well above average, Babich Wines' focus remains on producing wines of exceptional quality, that exemplify Marlborough's renowned purity and intensity of flavour.


A charming neighbourhood café housed in 'The Falls

- **1. Trim the Stems** Always cut Lisianthus stems at an angle before placing them in water. This increases the surface area for water absorption and prevents the ends from sealing up.
- **2. Use Clean Water** Change the water every two days and ensure your vase is clean to prevent bacteria from shortening the flowers' lifespan.

- **3. Remove Foliage Below the Waterline** Any leaves left submerged will rot quickly, leading to bacterial growth that affects the flowers.
- **4. Keep Away from Direct Sunlight & Heat** While Lisianthus love the sun when growing, once cut, they prefer a cool environment. Keep them away from direct sunlight, heaters, and fruit, as the ethylene gas released by ripening produce can cause flowers to wilt faster.
- **5. Add Flower Food** A little flower food or a homemade solution of sugar and a drop of bleach can help nourish your blooms while keeping bacteria at bay.

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#### WHAT IS MPOX

#### with Waitakere i-Medical Centre

Mpox (formerly known as monkeypox) is caused by the monekypox virus. There are different types of mpox called clades. People can get treatment however they can be seriously ill once they get it.

#### What are the symptoms of Mpox

Symptoms usually appear 1 to 3 weeks and they are;

- Headache
- Fever (temperature higher than 38 degrees Celsius)
- · Chills
- · Muscle and Back aches
- Swollen lymph nodes in your neck, armpit or groin.

Lesions can then develop which are in the form of spot, bumps, blister or sores appearing on the skin after a few days. They can appear in any part of your body such as face, mouth, arm, legs, genitals and anus. The lesions are often painful and itchy and you may also have pain, bleeding and uncomfortable feeling in your anus. The symptoms usually go away by themselves within 2 to 4 weeks.

#### How is Mpox spread?

- Mpox can spread when there is direct contact with the skin lesions, scabs, or body fluids and through intercourse.
- Touching clothing, bedding towel or other object which have been used by the person with Mpox.
- · Through sex which is the most risk factor

#### What happen if I get Mpox?

• If you test positive for Mpox, public health staff will be in contact to support you and provide advice on your



symptom and the precautionary measures . You will not be asked to isolate.

• If you need to attend a healthcare clinic, advise them you have Mpox and cover any lesions or sore and wear a mask during your visit.

#### Stopping the spread of Mpox

- Keeping scabs and lesions covered until the skin has healed
- · Avoiding physical contact with other
- Not sharing clothing, bedding or utensils
- Cleaning the bathroom after use
- Avoiding contact with pregnant people, young children, people with severe eczema and immunocompromised people
- Avoiding contact with household pet as they can get and spread the virus.

#### Vaccination

The Mpox vaccine called Jynneous has been given provisional approval by Medsafe for eligible people. Please talk to your healthcare provider about being vaccinated

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#### Flat bread dough:

- 100g bakers flour
- 100g yoghurt
- Tea spoon dry yeast
- Table spoon olive oil
- Teaspoon salt

- Boil minted baby peas and shelled edamame beans for 3 minutes
  - Drain and cool quickly in cold water.
- 2. Whip ricotta and honey together in blender or food processor.
- 3. Roll out dough then grill on dry non-stick pan for around 1 minute each side.
  - Drizzle flat bread with garlic and olive oil base

#### **TO SERVE**

Smother ricotta honey mix over warm flat bead add peas, edamame, mint and basil, chilli flakes and flaky salt to season




